**Title:** *Translating Oncology Clinical Research into Patient Impact*

**Abstract:** Join us for an BME seminar on how oncology clinical research moves from bench to bedside. Dr. Korchin will explore the roles of Medical Affairs and Contract Research Organizations (CROs) in accelerating drug development and ensuring patient-centric strategies. The seminar will also highlight how biomedical engineering innovations- such as advanced diagnostics, targeted drug delivery, and digital health- are shaping the future of cancer care.

**Bio:** Dr. Borys Korchin is a board-certified oncologist with over 30 years of experience in clinical practice, drug development, and medical affairs in oncology and hematology. He has served as Principal Investigator and Medical Director on more than 30 oncology studies, including 15 Phase I/II trials. Dr. Korchin holds a PhD in Pharmacology and is an Adjunct Professor at the University of Houston. His expertise spans early-phase clinical research, translational medicine, and strategic leadership in biotech innovation.
